

Swim with a view

Step-by-step pool construction using the example of a newly renovated pool in eastern France

The panorama is unique: on one side, you can see the green mountain slopes of the Parmelan, and on the other, the rolling hills around Doucy. Here, at 800 m above sea level, the Costa family has fulfilled their dream of owning their own home with a pool. More than 20 years old, the pool has been completely redesigned and equipped with a turbine swimming system from BINDER.




1 | The old pool had a dome-shaped pool roof.



2 | The shallow-water lounging zone is created at the left edge of the pool and all pipelines are laid.



3 | The cement for the new pool tiles is dry and the shell of the sundeck is in place.



4 | HydroStar turbine swimming system needs very little space for installation. The installation shaft, which is integrated into the pool wall, is only 515 mm deep.

5 | The new exquisite ceramic sandstone tiles with wood optic are laid. The sun deck was planned so that the pool cover can be retracted underneath, making it invisible.



Swimming is both sport and wellness at the same time; with a turbine swimming system from BINDER, it becomes a real experience.
